

ATTENDANCE & ACADEMIC POLICIES

Parents, guardians and students should reference the Launch Important Dates document (see page 2) for drop date and marking period information.

Attendance Policy

Students are expected to participate in Launch courses daily. Participation is defined as submitting assignments and attending live lessons with Launch instructors, when applicable.

- **Tier 1: 5-Day No Submission:** Guardian receives phone call from a member of the Launch Cares counseling team.
- **Tier 2: 10-Day No Submission:** Guardian receives phone call from a Launch administrator.
- **Tier 3: 15-Day No Submission:** Guardian receives email notification that the student has been suspended from Launch.
 - Students who are suspended will be provided a date by which to appeal, found on Parent Portal, in the email notification. Students are allowed one attendance appeal per academic year.

If a student is dropped from Launch programming, the resident district will be notified and must provide a list of educational options for the student. The student may not re-enroll with Launch for the remainder of the year and/or the following semester.

Academic Performance Policy

Following the 20th day of the semester, the Launch office generates a weekly report of students failing 3 or more courses.*

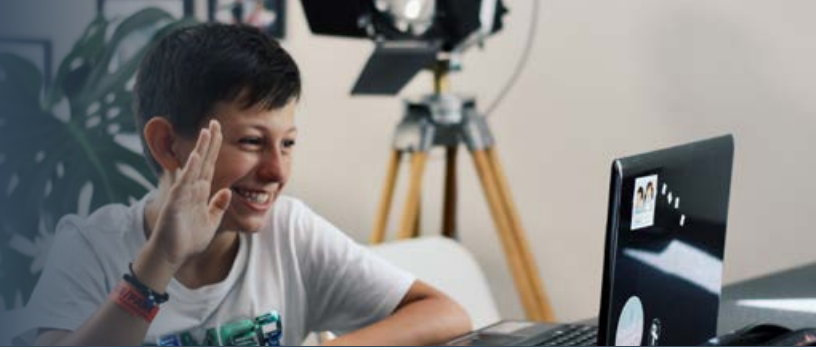
- These students will be monitored academically for the remainder of the marking period. Guardians will be notified by Launch staff.

- Students who are no longer failing 3 or more courses* at the end of the marking period will be removed from academic monitoring.
- Students who are failing 3 or more courses* at the end of the marking period will be suspended from Launch programming.
- Students who are suspended will be provided a date by which to appeal, found on Parent Portal, in the email notification. Students are allowed one academic appeal per academic year.
- If the appeal is approved, students will be placed on academic probation and will have one marking period to meet academic requirements.
- If an appeal is not submitted or denied, the student will be withdrawn to the resident district. The resident district will be notified and must provide a list of educational options for the student. The student may not re-enroll with Launch for the remainder of the year and/or the following semester.

State Testing Requirements

All students in grades 3-12 must complete required state testing per Missouri Law. These tests typically occur in April and May and can be taken virtually. Failure to participate in state testing will result in being withdrawn from the program and students will return to their district of residence.

**Note: Failing 2 or more courses on a 4-block schedule.*
