Audience

Who is eligible to take Launch's English Language Development courses?

Students who wish to take Launch's ELD courses must meet the Missouri Department of Elementary and Secondary Education's definition of an English Language Learner.

How will these courses balance synchronous and asynchronous time with the teacher?

Our ELD adapted courses are asynchronous in nature but still allow students access to an ESOL certified educator. Those courses, English I, Health, Personal Finance, and Government are adapted to ensure language-rich instruction that is adapted to meet the needs of those still acquiring academic English.
